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#### 1 Introduction

The packaging manual for suppliers is a written definition of the generally applicable logistics requirements posed to the suppliers by J.M. Voith SE & Co.KG (VTSK) and valid as contractual agreements in addition to the general purchasing conditions.

In order to enable an effective handling of the large amounts of goods that arrive at our plant in Salzgitter, only standardised packaging material must be used. Deviations from this standard must be contractually agreed by the purchaser in collaboration with the logistics department (e.g. small goods).

Objective of the supplier's manual:

- → Unique standards for suppliers and VTSK
- → Consistent protection of the material
- → Avoiding multiple handling
- → Efficient handling of incoming deliveries
- → Cost optimisation

This guideline applies for all deliveries. The packaging manual is an addition to the applicable contractual agreement.

#### 1.1 Delivery address:

Stock goods go to our external store, a part of the goods is delivered directly to VTSK. The correct address is communicated in the course of the respective order.

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#### 1.3 Delivery times

**VTSK plant**: Mo – Fr: 7:00 – 14:00 hrs (long goods, sheet metal)

Mo - Fr: 7:00 - 16:30 hrs

**Rudolph Logistik GmbH**: Mo – Fr: 7:00 – 18:00 hrs

Deviations (holidays, bridging days etc.) will be communicated in advance in writing.

### 2 General rules:

- 1) It is a mandatory requirement that the load must be properly secured
- 2) Only fully intact shipping containers may be used
- 3) As a general rule, materials must not project beyond the load carrier
- 4) Each delivery note must state the order number, delivery note number, Voith material number, designation, quantity delivered, contact information of the supplier, gross and net weight, unloading point
- 5) Mechanically machined parts must be free of oil and grease
- 6) Goods without a delivery note will not be accepted
- 7) The ordered quantity must be delivered exactly or within mutually agreed tolerance limits
- 8) Deviations in quantity must be agreed with VTSK in advance
- 9) The quantity stated on the delivery note must match the quantity delivered
- 10) The parts must be packed so that the quantity can be clearly identified without the need for repacking.
- 11) Different material numbers must not be delivered in <u>the same</u> container (only 1 material number per container)
- 12) Each (goods) item must be clearly identified (material number + designation).





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- 13) **Ordered sets** (various parts with one common material number) must be packed and labelled together as sets (**SET** labelling). Admissible packaging materials include foil bags, cardboard boxes or security threads, etc. (this is also true for the reverse case, where, for example, 10 parts are plugged together)
- 14) The load must be distributed evenly.
- 15) if there are several load carriers / packages, they must be numbered (1 of x) accordingly; the delivery note must always be attached to the first load carrier / package.
- 16) With materials to be handled in batches, the batch must be identified on the material (in permanent lettering)
- 17) Cardboard boxes must not weigh more than 20 kg (CEP shipping)
- 18) Suppliers from countries where pallet cages and Euro pallets are official means of exchange should also use them as a priority. From countries where these load carriers are not official means of exchange, care should be taken to ensure that special load carriers in Euro pallet dimensions (120x80) are used and that they are easy to open (use screws instead of nails).

### 3 Packaging

#### 3.1 General packaging guidelines

#### **Basic packaging information**

- Observe the weight limits of the load carriers (refer to standard or manufacturer information).
- Observe the load centre of load carriers and mark if necessary. -> Asymmetric: mark centre of gravity.
- Materials must not be free to move around in the packaging and on the load carrier. A form-fit and force-fit connection must be ensured.
- When lashing, the materials must be protected from damage caused by the lashing strap.
- The lashing strap must be routed to avoid damage to the load carrier.
- The material must be packed such that each load carrier contains one type of item only.
- As a general rule, the packaging should be chosen so as to be easily removable (for example, screws instead of nails)
- The load carrier must remain stackable at all times. If the material exceeds the dimensions of a half-height pallet cage (G2), suitable packaging like a UIC pallet cage, a disposable pallet or a euro pallet must be used.





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- Machined surfaces must be protected by means of auxiliary means like surface protection netting or similar.
- Items with a limited shelf life (best before date) must be marked with the <u>date of manufacture</u> on the material
- The respective delivery instruction must be observed for sheet metal and bar stock (see annex 1)
- Lacquer/paint => must be delivered packed securely for transportation under applicable law and contain:
  - a. Safety data sheet according to applicable legislation
  - b. Minimum durability must be at least half a year, especially in case of water-based paint
- Hazardous substances (paint, varnishes, GFRP products) have to be registered with the gatekeeper, as they have to be unloaded at a separate location. The carrier is instructed.
- Painted components must be appropriately protected so that the paint is not damaged/scratched during transportation or order picking. E.g. cover plates and frames
- Many components are delivered in large quantities (well protected). During order picking, however,
  the components are separated and transported onwards, so that adequate protection must also be
  provided here (individual protection of each component). Example: Pins on solenoid valves must be
  individually protected.

Should the supplier state that additional measures for protecting the material are required, these should be taken in consultation with Voith.





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### 3.2 Delivery of fixed lengths

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### 3.3 Handling of load carriers

Material must be delivered neither in defective nor in dirty load carriers. The general exchange criteria must be observed.

Old labels must be removed from the load carrier prior to shipping.

VTSK reserves the right to invoice the cost of repair for defective load carriers plus a processing fee to the responsible company, see para 6.

#### Notifying the carrier of a shipment:

When registering goods for shipment with DHL, be sure to the appropriate DHL terminology. When registering, it is mandatory to observe the following:

### 3.5 Procurement of packaging

In principle, the returnable load carriers approved by Voith must be exchanged for corresponding empties directly upon delivery or there is an exchange account. The supplier is obliged to provide sufficient empties. Exceptions must be clarified with the logistics of VTSK in advance.





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#### **Defective load carriers**

### 1. Euro pallets (EN 13698-1)

If Euro pallets show one of the following defects, they must not be used anymore or must be repaired:

→ The label EUR or the sign of a European railway company is missing on a pallet,



→ One bottom or top border plank is so heavily damaged that one nail or screw shaft is visible,



→ A plank is split across or biaswise broken,






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ightarrow A log is missing or split in a way that more than one nail is visible,



 $\rightarrow$  A plank is missing.







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The pallet cannot be exchanged anymore if:

- → The load capacity is no longer guaranteed,
- → Soiling is so severe that the load is contaminated,



- → Several logs are heavily splintered,
- → Manifestly inadmissible components have been used,
- → Timber is missing completely or partly,
- → Screws or nails jut out of the pallet,
- → No admissible marking is visible.

### • Pallet cages DIN 15155 (UIC 435-3):

If pallet cages DIN 15155 (UIC 435-3) show one of the following defects, they must not be used anymore:

→ The corner posts are deformed,







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→ The hinged front panels (upper and lower) are immovable or deformed in a way that the pallet cage cannot be closed anymore,



→ The floor frame or the pallet feet are so heavily bent that the pallet cage no longer stands firmly on 4 feet



→ The wire mesh is so torn that the wire ends extend to the inside or outside, (one missing mesh per side is allowed),







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→ A plank is missing or broken,



The supplier is invoiced for the delivery of poor quality euro pallets or pallet cages.

#### 3.7 VCI – Packing instructions

The material must be protected from corrosion.

The following procedures must be undergone according to VCI:

- Metal parts that are sensitive to corrosion must not be touched with unprotected hand (Wear gloves).
- The distance between the VCI material and the metal should be maximum 30 cm depending on the application. In case of larger packed goods, additional VCI material must be inserted.
- Corrodible parts must be packed in VCI foil and sealed with adhesive tape.

If the goods are not packed in VCI foil, a suitable preservation (released by VTSK) must be applied.





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#### 4 Documents

#### 4.1 Delivery note

For goods receipt at incoming goods department, VTSK needs a delivery note that clearly describes the delivery. The delivery note must be situated on the goods and visible from the outside. The order numbers etc. on the delivery notes must be correct.

The delivery note must contain the following information:

- Oder number/delivery plan number (order number = 451.. or delivery plan = 551...),
- VTSK material number of all sent material. This must also include, for example reference pieces or samples
- Quantity delivered
- Contact information of supplier
- Contact information of purchaser (VTSK)
- Best before date (if relevant)
- Delivery note no.
- · Gross and net weight
- Unloading point (delivery address)
- · Quantity of load carriers delivered
- Load carrier designation (e.g. pallet cage, wooden pallet, euro pallet, including quantity of small load carriers)

#### 4.2 Certificates / first sample reports

Certificates or first sample reports must be sent to the following E-mail address 24h before the delivery of the goods:

The file name must be "Orderno\_Item\_Materialno\_Batch.pdf" or "EMP\_Orderno\_Materialno\_Batch.pdf".

First samples must be marked in the load carrier.







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#### 4.3 Invoices

Invoices must be issued in accordance with § 14 of the UStG. The VTSK order number must be documented. The invoice remains unchanged.

#### 4.4 Goods tags

In order to ensure the identification and traceability of parts from suppliers, it is necessary that valid goods tags are attached to the packaging material. The goods tag should orient itself toward the VDA Recommendation 4902.

### The following requirements must always be documented by the supplier:

(1) Consignee (9) Filling quantity (container) (2) Unloading point, storage location (10) Designation delivery / performance (3) Delivery note no. (11) Order no. / delivery plan no. (4) Supplier address (short name, site, postal code, place) (12) Supplier no. (5) Net weight (13) Date (6) Gross weight (14) Design revision status (7) Quantity of package (15) Package no. (8) VTSK material no. (16) Batch no. / first sample

In addition, the following must be completed: (17) Hazardous substances

The goods tags should not be fixed under the strapping band or lashing strap.

If the delivery note contains several items, the item must be marked in the container. A logistic notice of defects will be issued from 2015-10-01 if the goods tag as per VDA 4902 is not available.





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### 4.5 Attachment of the goods tags

one goods tag must be attached to each unit in the top right corner on the long side.







### Negative example (n. ok) => goods must not be delivered this way



There is no practical possibility to count.

The goods are well stacked on the side, but in the middle, it is impossible to determine the quantity.





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There is no practical possibility to count.



The material lies loose on the lorry.

The material must be delivered in or on the specified load carriers.



Delivery on pallet:

The steel belts are torn on the right side.

Stack the material in only one layer.





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The pallet cage is too heavy and cannot be stacked anymore, the pallet cage is pressed apart. The material projects the pallet cage.

Load securing is not sufficient.



Delivery on pallet:

The steel straps are torn and the euro pallet is defective.

The euro pallet must be in faultless condition.





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### 5 Non-observance of the packaging manual

As the supplier, you are responsible for the proper use and handling of the packaging.

You must also assume your part of the overall responsibility for the compliance with general legal requirements and the special packaging guidelines defined by VTSK.

We reserve the right to send back all incoming goods not corresponding to the standards defined by VTSK in this manual at the supplier's expense.

The costs for damages of the material resulting from inadequate packaging, wrong handling and/or the use of wrong or damaged transport containers are charged to the supplier.

If damage of the material is detected in the course of quality testing and results from the causes mentioned above, the supplier will be invoiced for this belatedly.

Basically, all goods without valid accompanying documents corresponding to the standards defined in this manual are not accepted.

In case of deviations from this manual, we reserve the right to invoice the responsible company with a lump sum of €100 per case or complaint (for example, defective load carrier, excess quantities delivered, missing documentation etc.).

Please note that you as the supplier are obligated to observe the specifications described in this manual.





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### 6 Severability clause

Should a provision of this contract be null and void, the remaining provisions shall continue to be effective. The parties undertake to replace the void provision by a regulation which is as similar as possible to the void provision.

We are looking forward to working together with you as partners.
